### **THE LOIS FRELS RESEARCH AWARDS GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA FOR APPLICANT**

The Lois Frels Research Award was established in 1991 and is presented to members of IASN in recognition of outstanding research which impacts school nursing and/or the health of children/youth. Dr. Lois Frels is former certified school nurse who has encouraged school nurses to do nursing research and remains a true friend to the school nursing profession. The amount of the award will be \$500.00

The research project shall be a **COMPLETED** project done within 24 months prior to the submission deadline of August 1. The winner(s) will be encouraged to enter the project for the NASN Lillian Wald Research Award, *but the completion time for NASN is 12 months*. An individual may enter the NASN Research Award independently of IASN. The award recipient will be encouraged to publish the research project. The award recipient will be expected to present at the IASN Annual Conference (abstract, poster session, etc.) as well as submit an IASN Newsletter article.

The applicant(s) shall be a qualified professional school nurse engaged in one of the following categories:

- A. The practice of school Nursing.
- B. The education of school nurses (nursing faculty).
- C. The study of school nursing (student for Masters).
- D. A retired member with active membership status.
- E. Past award winner(s) may submit new research projects every five (5) years.

The applicant(s) shall be an ACTIVE status member of IASN prior to submission of the research project.

The applicant(s) shall submit a Curriculum Vita (four copies).

The applicant(s) shall submit a project report of completed research, which includes at minimum:

- A. Title of study or project
- B. Purpose of study or project
- C. Clearly stated research question or hypotheses.
- D. Brief review of relevant literature on research topic.
- E. Description of the methodology used and the results of data collected.
- F. Description of the assumptions and limitations of the research project.
- G. Contribution the project will make to the field of school nursing and/or health of children/youth.

The following format will be used in writing entries:

- A. One page abstract
- B. Double spaced
- C. 1" margins
- D. APA format, current edition

The **Mini Grant Award** and **Achievement Award** were established in 2002 and were developed to recognize members of IASN.

The **Mini Grant Award** is presented for project development which impacts school nursing and/or health of children/youth. The Mini Grant Award shall be a project done within 24 months of the August 1 deadline.

The award recipient(s) will be expected to present at the IASN Annual Conference as well as submit an IASN Newsletter article.

The amount of the IASN Mini Grant Award will be \$200.

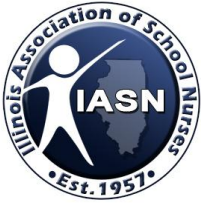
The **Achievement Award** is presented for achievement which impacts school nursing and/or health of children/youth.

The Achievement Award shall be recognition of achievement for different categories:

- 1. Published article.
- 2. National speaking presentation
- 3. Demonstration Project
- 4. Poster Session
- 5. School project, which involves children's activity.

The project shall be submitted within 24 months of the August 1 deadline.

The amount of the IASN Achievement Award is \$100.
